TYPE OF AWARD: Scholarship
AMOUNT OF AWARD: \$1,000.00
AWARDS per YEAR: Four (4)

FUNDING METHOD: Self-Directed

AWARD USE: For use in an accredited post-secondary school, college, or university in Manitoba for the

2025-2026 academic year. Awards may be used at Canadian schools outside Manitoba only

when the program of studies is not offered in Manitoba.

**Eligibility** 

WHO IS ELIGIBLE? Current members in good standing of the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local

998 and their family members.

FAMILY DEFINED AS: Spouse, children, stepchildren, grandchildren, brothers, sisters

ALSO ELIGIBLE: CUPE 998 summer students

REQUIREMENTS: Award open to students enrolled in any full-time program in the 2025/2026 year. (Full-time

as defined by the educational institution)

Previous award winners are not eligible.

### Criteria (NEW) The Criteria for the Reconcile Action Award is as follows

### **Selection Method**

SELECTION COMMITTEE: Consists of a chairperson and at least two (2) members from CUPE Local 998.

To ensure impartiality, selection committee members and their families are not eligible for the

scholarships.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Based on academic standing and short essay submission.

SELECTION PROCESS: The Selection Committee will review all application submissions and reserves the right to

conduct interviews if deemed necessary.
