CUPE 998 members must provide their banking information for direct deposit of their Strike Pay, as well as fill out the strike form which will be provided on-site

The CUPE form will require the name of your banking institution, the institution's address, transit number, institution number and account number.

Please bring a VOID cheque or use your online banking application to gather the required information. Alternatively, you may contact your bank in advance to get the required information.
